Weather Affected Fixtures Policy

The following outlines Central Coast Football's Policy on Weather Affected Fixtures in the 2011 Competition.

Rescheduled Fixtures

All competition matches will be replayed in 2011. If part rounds are washed out, games will be rescheduled midweek or the first available wet weather allowance weekend.

There are 3 spare weekends at the end of the 14 rounds. The weekends will be used when full rounds are washed out.

When games are rescheduled after the weekend, Clubs will have a minimum of Four Days notice for a rescheduled match.

No Matches will be moved on weekends. If a ground is closed then the fixture will be postponed.

If grounds are closed by Council and there is an opportunity for games to be moved, clubs will be notified no later than 5pm Thursday of the rescheduled fixture.

Wet Weather

The status of all fields will be updated on the CCF website in the case of Wet Weather. This is the only place to find out the status of all grounds.

- Clubs are to inspect fields at 6am and notify CCF immediately during Wet Weather via SMS to 0424 505 267 should any grounds be closed on both Saturday and Sunday.
- CCF will update the website as soon as notifications are received.
- Clubs should clearly identify any fields that are closed using the field code and notify the duration of the closure i.e. is the field expected to be playable for Premier League later in the day.
- The CCF office is not manned on weekends so do not contact the office on weekends
- Notifications of field closures should be sent only to this one central point to avoid confusion between clubs.
