Re: Alcohol at Pluim Park – HIGH IMPORTANCE

Dear All

For the first time in several years, alcohol will be on sale at Pluim Park during the Statewide Insulation Cup and Central Coast Women's Cup competitions.

The Directors of Central Coast Football have made this decision based on the general feedback of the football community. At this stage, the liquor licence is temporary and any future consideration will be dependent on the success or otherwise of this trial.

We expect all Central Coast clubs and participants to adhere to all of the conditions in relation to the sale of alcohol at Pluim Park, namely:

- No alcohol to be brought into the venue (including teams);
- Alcohol to be consumed in the designated bar area only;
- People to recognise and accept that Central Coast Football will adhere to the Responsible Sale of Alcohol protocols.

We hope everyone will join us in ensuring that the reintroduction of the sale of alcohol to Pluim Park is a positive and enjoyable experience.

The bar will be open from **1.00pm to 6.00pm** this Sunday.
