



# Tigers triumph in a shoot-out

IT'S the season for grand final drama.

Hot on the heels of tight scorelines and extra time excitement in the Central Coast rugby union and rugby league grand finals, soccer got in on the act on Sunday night.

Wyoming claimed the Premier League 1 trophy with a thrilling 6-5 win over East Gosford in a penalty shoot-out at Central Coast Stadium.

The teams had been locked at 1-1 at the end of regular and golden-goal extra time.

In the penalty shoot-out, East Gosford blinked first when Wyoming goalie Andrew Bull ended the goal-for-goal exchange when he knocked down a strike from Byron Girvan.

Wyoming's Michael Kennedy then stepped up to the spot and knocked his shot past East Gosford goalie Andrew McCracken to seal victory.

Earlier, Brett Margin had given East Gosford a 1-nil lead at the break. Wyoming's Brad Lewis equalised in the second stanza.
