WYOMING UNDER 21 SIDE WINS MARGIN'S CUP

A specially selected team represented Wyoming Soccer Club in the prestigious Margin's Cup knock-out tournament held at Plum Park over the October long week-end.

The team consisted only of players under 21 years of age and ranged from Keenan Field (Under 15 Reps) to Nigel Forster (Senior Player of the Year), and included a number of players from Wyoming's Under 17 side as well as from the higher grades.

Forty-eight teams, many from strong Sydney clubs, vied for the Cup over a number of games at both Plum and Ourimbah grounds.

In a thrilling final on Monday, Wyoming defeated the C.C.S.A. side 2-1. Scorers for Wyoming were John Bailey and Connel Field.

The winners received the Margin Cup and a cheque for \$1500. The effort by Wyoming is certain to create much excitement through the Senior ranks of both Wyoming and other clubs on the Central Coast, and bodes well for the future few years for Wyoming's First Grade prospects.

SENIOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR



One of the most talented players to emerge from the Wyoming Soccer Club's junior ranks, 18-year-old NIGEL FORSTER, has won the Club's major playing award, the SENIOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR for 1992.

Nigel's undoubted talent came to light in his first season when he was Player of the Year in Wyoming's 1981 U/7B2 team, coached by Chris Bembrick. From 1984 to 1986 he played in Kevin Best's outstanding U/10 to U/12 teams, alongside three of his current 1st grade teammates in Danny Wilson, Ryan Marshall and Stuart McAteer. During this period he combined Saturday club soccer with Sunday representative soccer, being a member of the Central Coast U/11 team which won the NSW Northern Branch title in 1985.

With his selection in the 1987 U/13 Central Coast team, which played on Saturdays, Nigel no longer had the option of playing club soccer and left to concentrate on what was to become an outstanding junior representative career. He played for CCSA teams through until this season, when his university studies (he is in the first year of a Computer Science degree at Newcastle University) took precedence and led to his return to Wyoming.

For three years, from 1988 to 1990, he was a permanent member of Northern NSW teams, dropping out in 1991 only because of rep. baseball commitments, and in 1989 he was also selected in the U/15 NSW Country team.

This year's award will be Nigel's fourth major trophy in as many seasons, having won the CCSA U/15 Players' Player of the Year in 1989, and the U/17 Player of the Year in both 1990 and 1991.

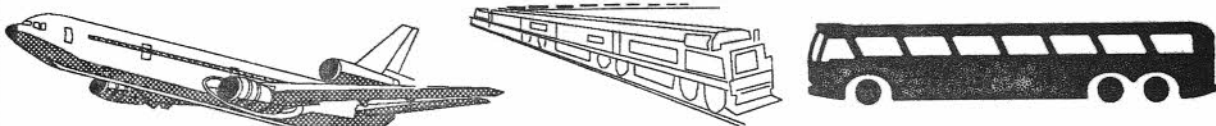
The Wyoming Soccer Club JUNIOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR award, traditionally awarded to the Player of the Year in the oldest junior age group, has been won this year by the Under 15A captain, BRADLEY HAM.

Now in his 11th season with Wyoming, 'Hammie' first played in the 1982 Under 6B team, making an immediate impact by being selected as the team's Most Improved Player. That 1982 trophy was destined to be joined over the following ten years by three premiership trophies, three runners-up trophies, two league championship trophies and three President's Trophy medallions.

Since 1984 he has played under three of the Club's leading coaches in Malcolm Moffat (1984-87 and 1990), Steve Field (1988) and Steve Frame (1989 and 1991-92). All three rate him as one of their most valuable players, an opinion supported by the fact that he has won Player of the Year trophies on four separate occasions - one of only five players ever to have done so.

The ultimate "quiet achiever", Brad has built a reputation over the years as one of the toughest, most fearless, defensive midfielders in his age group on the Coast. Despite this he has never resorted to foul play, and this combined with a fine, sportsmanlike attitude has earned him the respect of both opponents and teammates alike.

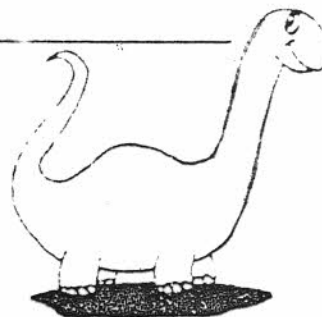


