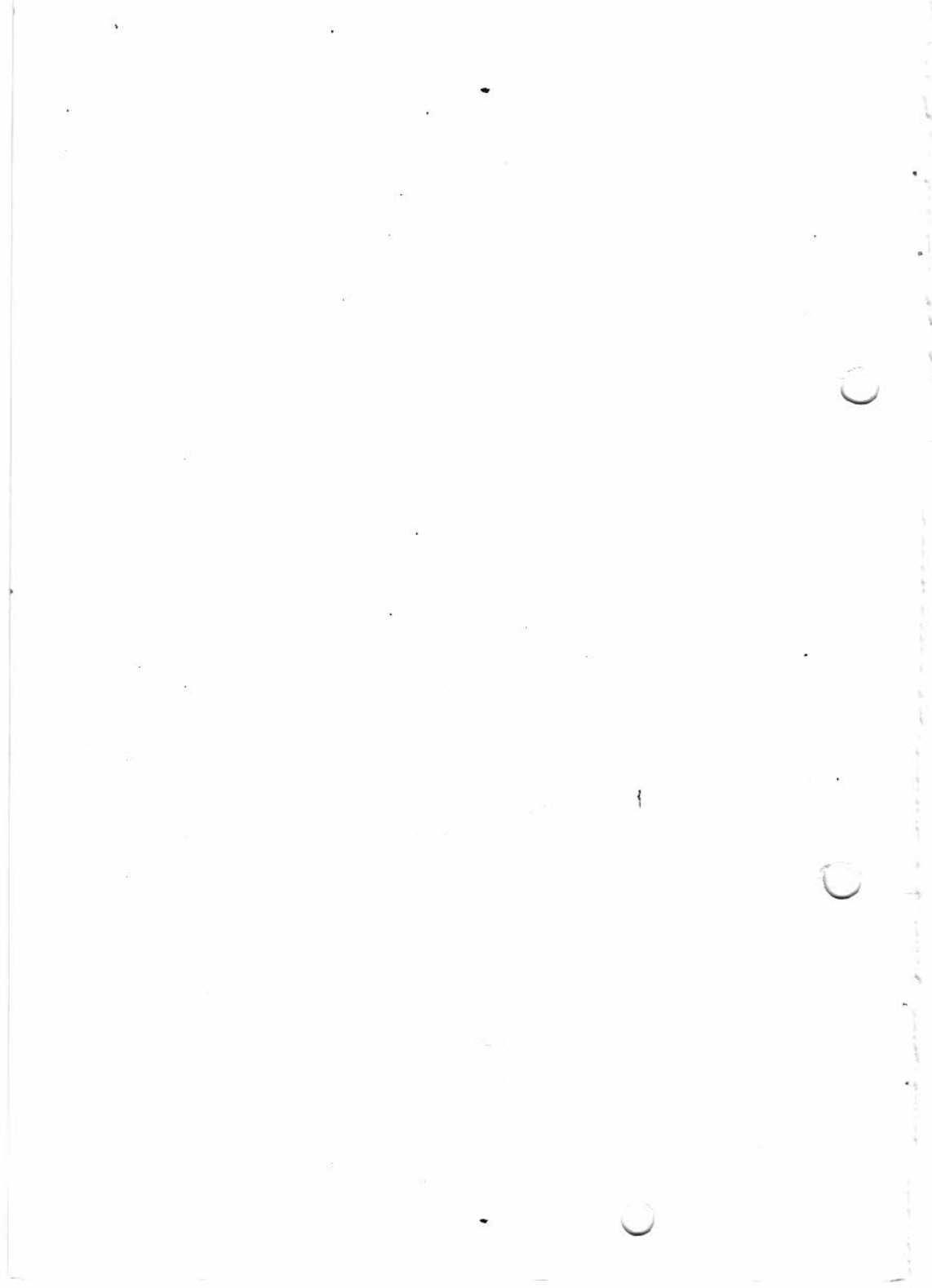

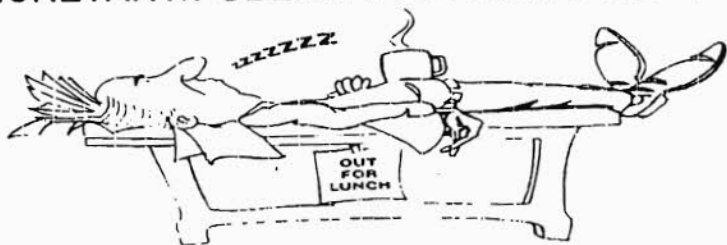
To all award winners, be they individual or team, extend my personal praise.
