And so, the second half of the season begins. Unluckily for the Gwandalan Cobras, they had to travel to us for their "home" game. Despite lingering at the bottom of the table, they were not a team to take lightly. They had held The Entrance to a draw and had scored their first victory last weekend over recent competition leaders, Killarney. For today's encounter, we would be reduced to 14 players with Tim (family-related) and Elton (a stair-related mishap) being late omissions; Scott Lee helped the A's again whilst Paul and Brad remained on the injury list. Brad got himself on the team sheet, but Sue and Julia were adamant he was not playing.

Gwandalan had the better of chances early on with a couple of shots - including a free header - but keeper Rob would quickly turn that around. With a high kick clearance, he sent the ball ahead of McGarvey to chase. His shot was deflected but not to fear, Webby was here. McGarvey was sandwiched in between a

kiwi combo here as Webb smashed his "tap-in" high into the net. A nice way to start Webby's 90th game for the team. Also celebrating a milestone - 60 appearances - McGarvey was soon on the scoreboard. The first came courtesy of a long ball from Cliff Kroemer. McGarvey pounced on it, teased the backline and goalie, and almost walked the ball over the line. He was in for his second courtesy of a through ball from Jay Paudel. The woodwork temporarily denied him his third, but it would come courtesy of Luca. Luca received the ball in front of goals but selflessly passed it onto Fitzzy in open space. Fitzzy's shot hit the underside of the crossbar and bounced back. Luca's effort in pursuing the ball was thwarted by an elbow from the Cobras' keeper. After much deliberation, the referee ruled a penalty. McGarvey finished it off. That goal marked his 70th, not bad at all in 60 games. Neale McAndrew had a couple of attempts, both sailing over the crossbar and Andy's closest jettisoned over the top right of the bar. At the other end, Gwandalan's most threatening player "Mike" - and inheritor of new fanboy Brad - saw an opportunity of an open goal from far out. His shot was well on target, but he had not accounted for our superstar goalie. Rob scrambled back, threw an arm out and impeccably timed it perfectly to knock the ball away.

Up 4-0, the second half was not quite the knock-out punch we had been striving for. There were plenty of chances though. Neale and Andy combined well on the corner kicks, one of which ended with an O'Connor header that veered wide. O'Connor had several attacking runs and should have finished the game with a penalty when he was taken down inside the box. McGarvey continued to cause trouble but would not find the net again. Both Micks gave great service too, but Andy and Geoff botched two of those chances in front of goals. The Cobras did not ruin their chance though when Wyoming's backline had pushed up to the halfway line with a free kick. The Cobras intercepted the ball and made a quick counter directly through the middle. It was the first goal Wyoming had conceded since Round 5. Special mention this week to Lawesy (also his 60th game) in the backline and Paudel in the holding position, both were solid. However, it was the Italian Stallion himself, Luca who picked up the MVP votes for the day with boundless energy and support. He capped it off with a strong run down the right flank and cut it across where Paudel beautifully sliced the ball into the left corner to make it 5-1. Nine straight wins!! Next week, we take on the only team we have not defeated yet, The Entrance.

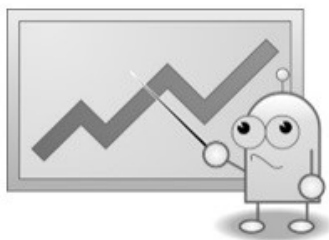
