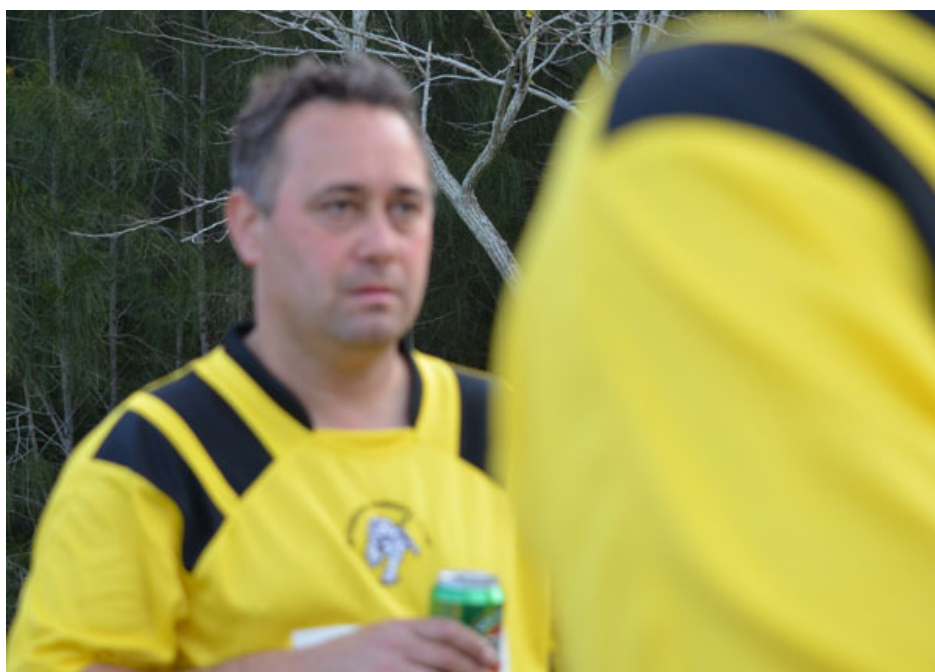

The players stop and look at the ref to learn the whistle came from another field.

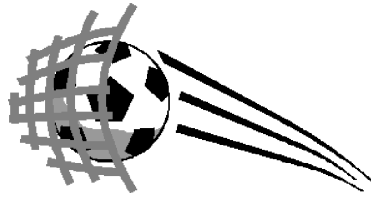
## THE QUICK TURN AROUND
